## DIRECTIONS

1) Teacher will need to cut along center lines to create the puzzles.
2) Students will put the puzzles together.
3) Students will segment the phonemes as they put the pictures together. (There are the same number of puzzle pieces for each phoneme in the word.)
4) Students can then blend the phonemes to create the word.

## QUICK DIFFERENTIATION

## KIDS THAT NEED A CHALLENGE:

I) Students can write the sounds they hear to write the word on the puzzle.
2) Students can write a sentence with the word.

KIDS THAT NEED A REVIEW:
I) Pull students up to a small group and have students tap each puzzle piece as they say the sounds in the word.
2) Give students only a few puzzle pieces to match at a time.



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
